## Firstfolio director going the distance for Leukaemia

**In his bid to raise \$10,000** for the Leukaemia Foundation, Warren Nicholls, the chief operating officer of Firstfolio's New-Loan division, has taken part in the 280-kilometre multidisciplinary Mark Weber Challenge.

Nicholls has competed against more than 80 entrants in travelling 280 kilometres on foot, across water, down cliff faces and on two wheels through the wilderness of Tasmania.

The multidisciplinary event, which took place on 19-23 November, has raised money for the Leukaemia Foundation and the Save the Tassie Devil Appeal.

Funds raised will go towards the

purchase of a two-bedroom apartment in East Melbourne as part of the Emergency Accommodation Program run by the Leukaemia Foundation. This program provides Leukaemia patients and their families with a 'home away from home' while seeking treatment.
